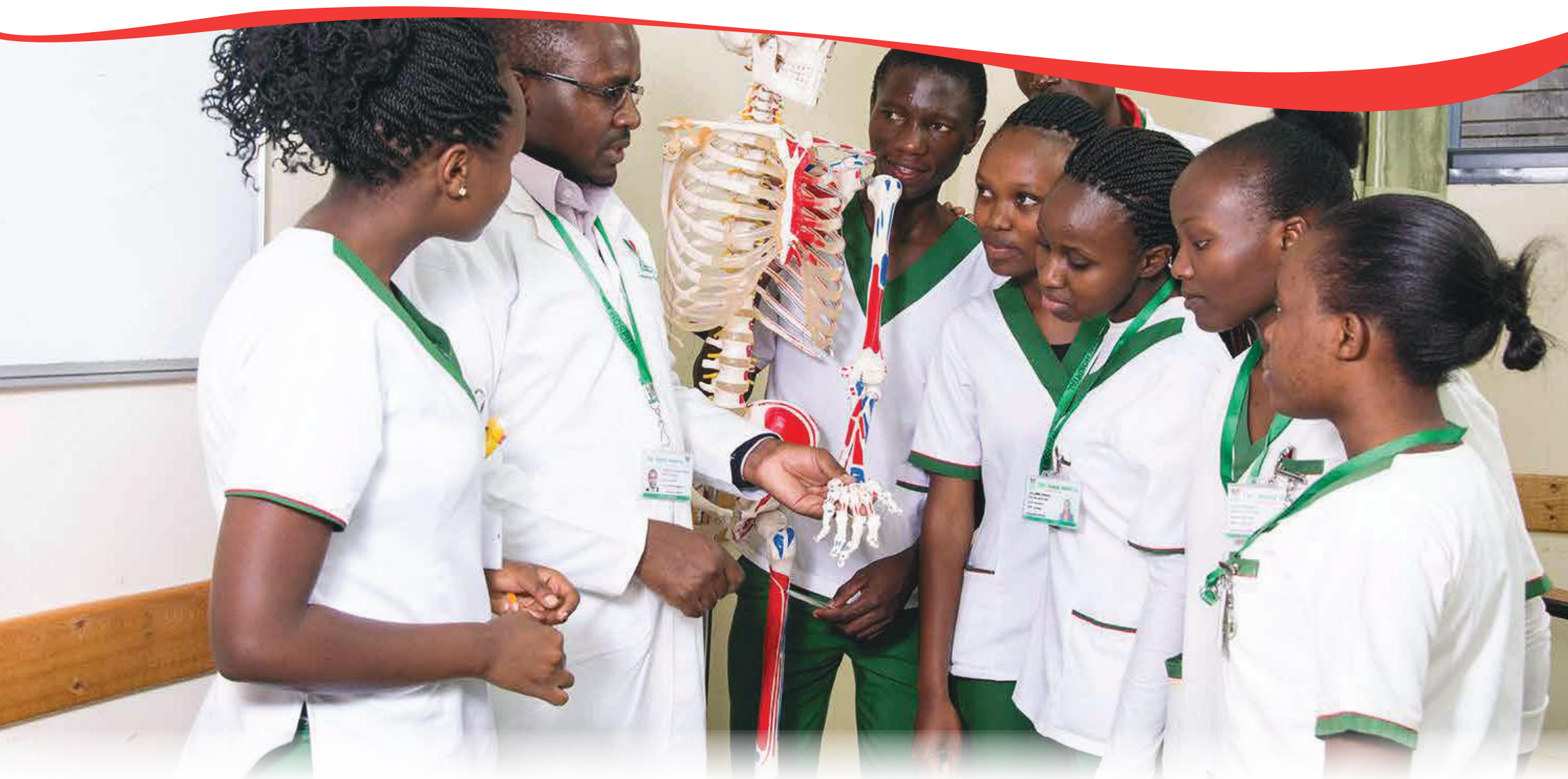




Kenya is currently facing shortage in the number of health workers. In order to serve patients better, the World Health Organization (WHO) has recommended 23 nurses for 100,000 patients. Kenya falls below this proposal of 12 nurses to serve 100,000 patients. Notably data available from clinical officers' council indicate that there are only two training centres for specialized clinical officers and none has any training in cardiology. Given the statistics, it is clear that the Kenyan healthcare system has large shortage of qualified healthworkers.

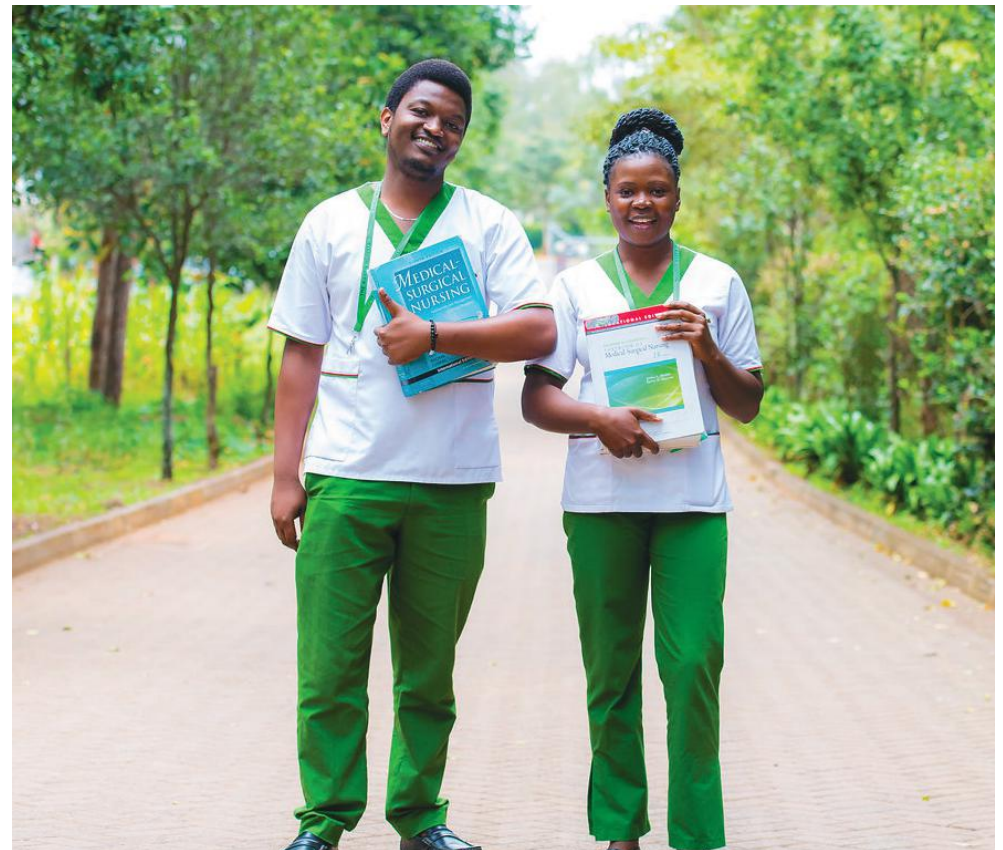
